Dave McCloughan



Dave McCloughan was an NFL Scout for 16 plus years for the Las Vegas Raiders. Currently Dave is a scout with the Jacksonville Jaguars. Dave is a high school 100- & 200-meter sprinter state champion in Colorado. A Kickoff Returner and Cornerback from the University of Colorado. He won a National Championship at Colorado by defeating the Notre Dame Fighting Irish in the 1991 Orange Bowl. A former Indianapolis Colts, Green Bay Packers & Seattle Seahawks Cornerback & special teams' player.

Ahman Green



Ahman Green is a 2-time National Champion at Nebraska. In 1996 beating the Florida Gators & in 1998 beating Peyton Manning's Tennessee Volunteers. The 1996 Orange bowl MVP vs the Tennessee Volunteers. Ahman is a Green Bay Packers Hall of Fame Running Back. Ahman is also the All-time Green Bay Packers Rushing Record holder with 8,322 yards. Ahman finished with 11,244 all-purpose yards during his NFL Career. Ahman Green & Bo Jackson were the only 2 players in NFL history to have 2 touchdown runs of 90 yards or more. Ahman gained more rushing yards & yards from scrimmage than any other NFL player from 2000-2004. A 4-Time NFL Pro Bowl Selection & the NFC Offensive Player of the year.

Adam Carriker



Adam Carriker is an 8-year NFL Vet. He was a Washington Redskins Team Captain. Adam was named the Strongest Washington Redskin. He was the St. Louis Rams Rookie of the year. He was the 1st Rookie in Rams Franchise History to start every game as a Rookie. Adam Carriker was drafted in the 1st round of the 2007 NFL draft. He was an All-American at the University of Nebraska. He is in the Nebraska Football Hall of fame. Voted the Best Nebraska Defensive End since the year 2000. Adam was Big 12 Defensive Lineman of the year in 2006. He was a 2-Time 1st Team All-Big 12 in 2005 & 2006. A Nebraska Team Captain in 2006. He led the Big 12 Football Conference in Sacks in 2005. He was a 3-year starter at Nebraska (2004-2006). Adam was the Nebraska Lifter of the year in 2004.

Ralph Tamm



Ralph Tamm is played in 10 NFL seasons from 1990-1999. He was a member of 2 Super Bowl championship teams. The first from Super Bowl XXVI with the Washington Commanders. The other with the San Francisco 49ers in Super Bowl XXIX.

Tony Davis



Tony Davis, nick-named “Tough Tony” for his tenacious play. Nebraska MVP of the Sugar Bowl vs the Florida Gators in 1974. He was also the MVP of the Cotton Bowl vs the Texas Longhorns in 1975. He was the All-time leading rusher in Nebraska History when his career was finished. He was drafted by the Cincinnati Bengals and an MVP for them. He also played for the Tampa Bay Buccaneers. On New Year’s Day in New Orleans in 2022, he was inducted into the Sugar Bowl Hall of Fame.

Josh Davis



Josh Davis is a high school 200-meter sprinter state champion in Colorado. Nebraska I-Back, Kickoff Returner & Punt Returner. Big 12 Conference All-Time Career Kickoff Return yardage record holder with 2,265 yards. Nebraska All-Time single-game, single-season & career Kickoff Return yardage record holder with 2,265 yards. In the 2002 National Championship game vs the University of Miami Hurricanes he set the BCS Rose Bowl record for total return yards & yards per return avg vs the Miami Hurricanes. In 2003 he started at I-back, kickoff Return & Punt Return. Voted Honorable-Mention All-Big 12 in 2003. Free agent to the New York Jets in 2004.

Joey Rucks



Joey Rucks is a former CSU Ram that started on Cornerback for the Rams defense in 2006 & 2007. Joey led the Rams defense in tackles for loss with 8 in 2007. He had a career best 11 total-tackles in 2007 vs the University of Houston. Joey was the MWC Special teams' player of the week with 4 total-tackles & a fumble recovery vs Wyoming in 2005.
